#### Stick Science / Spear



Guidance Note's

Bo- jutsu is a Japanese martial art using a staff usually about 6 to 7 feet long called Bo. The art is similar to Jo-jutsu and Naginata. The system is strongly focused upon defence against the Japanese sword. Bo-jutsu techniques, involves locking, striking, thrusting restraining and immobilising.

The Naginata is between 6 to 8 feet in length and is one of several varieties of traditionally made Japanese swords in the form of a pole weapon with a curved blade on one end. Naginata were originally used by the samurai class of feudal Japan, and (foot soldiers). Naginata techniques, involves locking, striking, thrusting restraining and immobilising.

All Kobudo grades have just the one level of pass.

7<sup>th</sup> Kyu/Mon Ma

The emphasis on this grade is and a basic knowledge, guard positions and the ability to move form guard in continual movements.

6<sup>th</sup> Kyu/mon

Yellow Belt

The emphasis on this grade is basic defence and understanding the principles of combinations attacks.

5<sup>th</sup> Kyu/Mon
Orange Belt

The emphasis on this grade is a high standard of defence techniques and a good level of grip changes.

4th Kyu/Mon Green Belt Pass mark 65%
The emphasis on this grade is speed, balance, control, co-ordination, stamina, Knowledge of counters and combinations with good fighting spirit in contesting.

**Blue Belt**The emphasis on this grade is on style and fluidity and a full understanding of *kata* and its *bunkai*.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Kyu/Mon**The belt of knowledge, a vast understanding of *Bo-jitsu* and *Naginata* techniques, translations and ability to teach others.
